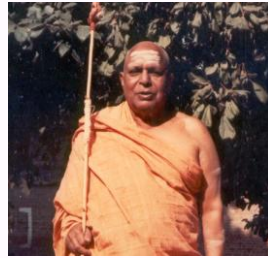




An incident from Swami Akhandananda's life

Late Swami Akhandananda gave series of discourses on Bhagavatam in an Ashram of a Realised Soul. The Old Monk told him, "I have no money or gift to give you. But this is the fees I give you: -

'You never think you are a Jiva (individual soul) – you are always Siva (the Supreme Consciousness) – behave like that all the time. No sadhana necessary.'
