In the first stanza of Aksharamanamalai, the word "Agam" pronounced in Tamil way has two meanings:

- 1. The inner heart
- 2. The ego (I)

So it says:

Oh Lord Arunachala, in respect of the one who thinks of Arunachalam constantly in his "Agam" (i.e. Inner Heart), you completely extirpate (=annihilate) the Agam (I).

(Note: Root of I = Ignorance = Avidya when applied to individuals or Maya when applied collectively to the cosmic jurisdiction).
